- Transcripts** submitted in sealed, signed envelopes and mailed directly from the college or university to the following address:

- Personal statement** of one to two pages detailing your purpose for undertaking graduate work. Your statement must also identify your first and second choices of technical areas from the four ME concentrations: Biomedical Engineering (EBME); Engineering Innovation, Management and Leadership (EIML); Mechanical Engineering (EMAE); or Systems & Control Engineering (SCS)
- Resume/CV**
- Two letters of recommendation** from professional or academic sources (non-family) who can assess your academic preparation, abilities and accomplishments
