Statement of Objectives: The statement should be one or two pages long and include your purpose in undertaking graduate work and an explanation of your study and research interests, as they relate to your undergraduate and/or graduate study and professional goals.

Graduate Record Examination (GRE) Scores: We require all applicants to take the GRE exam. Scores older than five years will not be accepted. Qualified applicants can apply for a GRE waiver. Register to take your GRE exam or order your GRE scores here: <http://www.ets.org/gre>.

Tip: You will need to identify the academic institution you will wish to send your GRE scores to. The GRE institution code for Case Western Reserve University is 1105.
