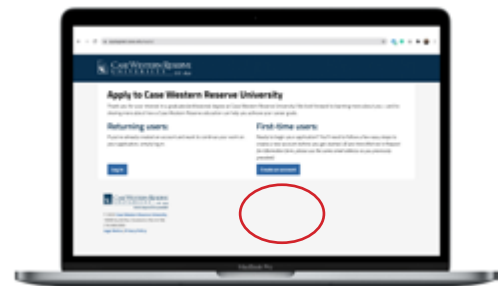




How to Apply to Online Engineering Master's Programs at Case Western Reserve University

1. Create an Account: Visit our [online application system](#) to get started. Click **Create an Account** and enter all required information. You will receive an email to activate your account with a temporary PIN. If you've already created an account, log in through the **Returning Users** section.



2. Start Your Application: First-time users will need to click **Start New Application**. Select the year you plan to enroll as well as the school, and click **Create Application**. Returning users will click on your existing application, and then click **Open Application**.



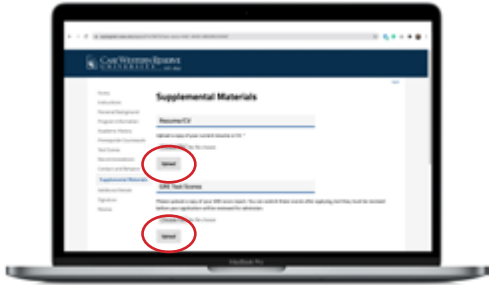
3. Select Program Details: Choose the online program you plan to pursue and semester you plan to start. Under Program, be certain to select the degree option that includes (online) at the end. If the term you want to apply for is not displayed, the deadline may have passed or the program will not be starting that term. Refer to the deadlines listed on our [admissions page](#) for up-to-date information.





4. Complete Academic History: Upload all unofficial transcripts from every post-secondary institution attended. International students must provide certified scanned translations and/or a WES evaluation if documents are in a language other than English.

5. Submit English Proficiency Scores: You will be asked if English is your native language. If the answer is no, submit your unofficial score report or indicate that you qualify for a waiver based on your education.



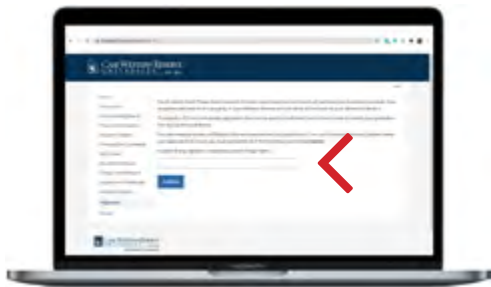
6. Submit GRE Score: MS applicants are required to submit unofficial scores during the application process. Applicants to the online Master of Engineering program do not need to submit GRE scores.

7. Submit Recommendations: Your two required recommenders will receive an email containing a link to submit their rating and letter through our online system

8. Complete Conduct and Behavior, Supplemental Questions, and Additional Details: In these sections, you will answer questions about your background, financial assistance, military service and relationship to CWRU. You will also submit your personal statement and resume/CV.

9. Review and Sign Application: Review your application to address any errors, and then digitally sign your application.

10. Submit Application Fee: Enter your credit card information to pay your non-refundable \$50 application fee. Finally, enter your name and the current date in the provided fields and click **Submit Application**.



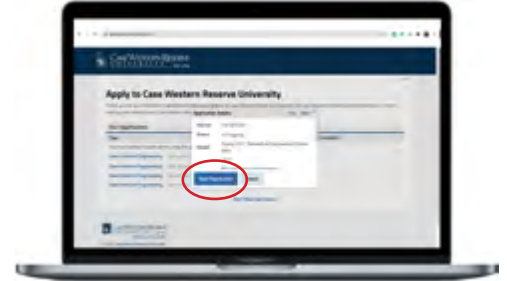

11. Check Your Application Status: Log into our [online application system](#). Click **Open Application** to view your student status page. Here, you can upload additional documents and update your contact information. If there is a yellow status update, select **View Update** to access your admission decision letter. If accepted, you must accept or decline the offer from admissions.
