- Bachelor's degree** (Bachelor of Science in engineering preferred)
 - Applicants with a non-engineering degree are required to demonstrate proficiency in calculus and differential equations
- GRE scores: In response to concerns about the COVID-19 virus, MS applicants for the summer and fall 2020 terms will not be required to submit GRE scores.**
- Transcripts** submitted in sealed, signed envelopes and mailed directly from the college or university to the following address:
